



Crutch

Finished height 5"

Skill Level:
Intermediate

Skills used:
I-chord

Yarn: 1 skein each dark grey and light grey Brown Sheep Nature Spun – sportweight

Needles: Size 2.5 DPNs

Gauge: Not important

Notions: stitch holder, tapestry needle

box in pattern is to check off rows or steps completed.

Start at bottom with bobble

With dk. grey yarn, CO 1 st leaving a tail.

K into the front and back of this st 3 times. [6 st]

Work in St st for 4 rows.

RS row, K2tog 3 times. [3 st]

P one row.

K3tog [1 st rem] Fasten off leaving tail long enough to thread on a tapestry needle.

Take the 2 tails and tie tog over the purl side. Pull tightly; a double knot may tighten further.

With lt. grey yarn, Pick up 5 sts evenly around bobble.

Work 5 st I-chord for 10 rows.

Next row: K 1, K into front and back. Place last 3 sts on st holder. Continue I-chord on 3 sts for 3.5 inches. Place sts on holder.

Pick up 3 sts from holder, join yarn and knit I-chord for 3.5 inches.

Place 6 sts from each I-chord section onto one needle in line.

With dk. grey yarn, K3, increase 1, K3, inc 1. Turn.

P8, inc 1. Turn.

K9

P9

K9

BO 9 sts and cut tail for sewing down.

Last part: **Hand grip**

With dk. grey yarn, CO 3 sts.

work I-chord for 3 rounds. Secure end. Sew in hand grip 2/3 down from top.

Weaving in ends and sew down pieces. Block.
