

Duffer Cuff

Argyle wrist warmers

Skill Level:

Intermediate - Advanced

Skills used:

Two stranded knitting

Knitting abbreviations:

See Appendix

Yarn: 1 skein, Knit Picks Dye Your Own Sock Yarn (100g)

Uses 12g for main color (dyed) & 12g for contrasting color

For my main color, I used hand painted Sleeping Dragon Sock Yarn found at www.aswellyarnshop.com

Needles: Size 1.5, dpns.

Gauge: 32 sts over 4" in charted pattern.

Notions: tapestry needle

Pattern: Make 2

With Main color, cast on 60 sts LOOSLY.
Work (K2, P2) rib for 3 rows, K 1 row .
(this is included in chart A row -4 through -1))

Joining contrasting color, follow chart rows 1-30 in Argyle pattern.

Break contrasting color and work final 4 rows in main color.
Bind off. Repeat for second cuff.
