

Mitten Ornament

Finished size: About 4 inches long and 2½ inches wide, not including thumb.

Materials: Worsted weight yarn (Cascade 220) small amounts of white and red
1 set US size #7 double pointed needles, 2 stitch markers, sewing needle

box in pattern is to check off rows completed.

Directions: CUFF UP

With white yarn cast on 18sts and divide between three DPNs.

K 1 round, P 1 round, K 1 round. Cut white and join red.
(OR K 3 rnds of k1, o1 ribbing)

K 2 rounds

Start thumb gusset:

K first 8 sts, place a marker (PM), knit in front and back (INC) of next 2 sts, PM, K last 8 sts.

K 1 round, slipping markers.

K, slip marker (SM), INC in first st after marker, K across to within 1 st of next marker, INC in next st, SM, K last 8 sts.

K 1 round

K, slip marker (SM), INC in first st after marker, K across to within 1 st of next marker, INC in next st, SM, K last 8 sts.

K 1 round

K, slip marker (SM), INC in first st after marker, K across to within 1 st of next marker, INC in next st, SM, K last 8 sts. There should be 10 sts between markers for thumb at the end of this round.

K 1 round

Divide: K 8, remove marker, slip the 10 thumb sts on a stitch holder, remove last marker, then cast on 2 sts, and K across last 8 sts. (18 sts)

K 1 round

K 6 rounds.

Top decrease :

For one round, K2tog, k1* (12 sts)

K 1 round.

For one round, K2tog* (6 sts)

K 1 round.

Finish top with Kitchener stitch. There should be 6 sts divided between 2 dpns.

Thumb:

Pick up sts for thumb off the stitch holder, CO 2 sts. (12 sts)

K 2 rounds

For one round, K2tog, k1* (8 sts)

K 1 round.

For one round, K2tog* (4 sts)

Finish top with Kitchener stitch. There should be 4 sts divided between 2 dpns.

Weave in and cut yarn ends. Attach a length of yarn or ribbon at top of cuff for a hanging loop.
