

Twisted Lattice Cabled Hat

A wintry, soft, warm, cozy, non-itchy cabled hat.

Fits 21-22" head

Yarn: 100% cotton hand dyed – Araucania Nature

Cotton, Color: periwinkle

Gauge: 13sts/4"

17	inch long	Size 6	circular	needle	and/or	DPNs	or size	to get	gauge

 \square box in pattern is to check off rows completed.

Panel of 16 sts repeated 5 times around.

CO 80 sts

□ Ribbing Row 1: p2, *(k4, p4) repeat from * until 2 sts from end, p2. pm at beginning of round, connect for working in round. □ □ □ □ Ribbing Row 2-5: Work established pattern as in row 1.
Follow as written: Row 1: (pm, p2, 4stRC, p4, 4stLC, p2)* repeat from * 5 times. Row 2: knit the k sts & purl the p sts, slipping markers. Row 3: (p1, 3stRPC, 3stLPC, p2, 3stRPC, 3stLPC, p1, sm) repeat from * Row 4: repeat row 2 Row 5: (3stRPC, p2, 3stLPC) repeat 10 times. Row 6: repeat row 2
□ Row 7: sl 2 sts purlwise *(p4, 4stRC) repeat from * to 2 sts from end, 4stRC with last 2 sts and first 2 sl sts. □ □ □ row 8-11: repeat row 2 □ Row 12: repeat row 7 □ Row 13: repeat row 2 □ Row 14: (3stLPC, p2 3stRPC) repeat 10 times. □ Row 15: repeat row 2
□ Row 16: p1 (3stLPC, 3stRPC, p2, 3stLPC, 3stRPC) repeat from * 5 times, p1

☐ Row 17: repeat row 2

Decrease Rows:

□ Row 1: sl 2 sts purlwise *(p1, p2tog, p1, 4stRC, p4, 4stRC) repeat from * to 2 sts from end, 4stRC with last 2 sts and first 2 sl sts. □ Row 2: knit the k sts & purl the p sts. □ Row 3: (k2, p3, k4, p1, p2tog, p1, k2, sm) ☐ Row 4: repeat row 2 ☐ Row 5: (k2, p1, p2tog, k4, p3, k2) repeat 5 times □ Row 6: sl 2 sts purlwise *(p2, 4stRC, p3, 4stRC) repeat from * to 2 sts from end, 4stRC with last 2 sts and first 2 sl sts. Switch to double pointed needles □ Row 7: p2, k4, p1, p2tog, k2 *(k2, p2, k4, p1, p2tog, k2) repeat from * until end of round. ☐ Row 8: repeat row 2 □ Row 9: (k2, p2tog, k4, p2, k2) □ Row 10: (k2, p1, k4, p2tog, k2) □ Row 11: sl2 sts *(p1, 4stRC) repeat from * to 2 sts from end, 4stRC with last 2 sts and first 2 sl sts. ☐ Row 12: repeat row 2 ☐ Row 13: repeat row 2 ☐ Row 14: repeat row 2 □ Row 15: sl2 sts *(p1, 4stRC) repeat from * to 2 sts from end, 4stRC with last 2 sts and first 2 sl sts. □ Row 16: k2 *(p1, k1, k2tog, k1) repeat from * to 1 st from end, k2tog the last and first st of round. ☐ Row 17: repeat row 2 ☐ Row 18: (k1, p1, skp) ☐ Row 19: repeat row 2 □ Row 20: k1 *(p1, k2tog) repeat from* to 1 st from end, k2tog the last and first st of round. ☐ Row 21: repeat row 2 ☐ Row 22: k2tog around



Break yarn. With a tapestry needle, run the yarn through the remaining live sts. Weave end inside hat.



Appendix

St(s) = Stitch(s) St st = Stockinet stitch

Rnd = Round K = Knit P = Purl

pm = Place marker sm = Slip Marker

sl = Slip stitch from left to right needle

skp = slip stitch, knit next stitch, pass sliped stitch over knit stich

K2tog = knit two stitches together

cn = Cable needle

3stRPC = sl1 st to cn and hold to back of work, k2, p1 from cn 3stLPC = sl2 sts to cn and hold to front of work, p1, k2 from cn. 4stRC = sl2 sts to cn and hold to back of work, k2, k2 from cn. 4stLC = sl2 sts to cn and hold to front of work, k2, k2 from cn.
